Dear Friends,



Thanks for coming to Holy Mass on this first week-end of 2010. May the Lord bless you and your family with health, peace, and all that you need for an enjoyable and happy New Year. I sincerely thank all who gave sacrificially of their time, talent and treasure during the past year and I pray that everyone will be involved in giving their very best during the coming year. As Matthew Kelly tells us in his book “Rediscovering Catholicism” we all need to work hard at becoming the “best version of ourselves” in order to be show God that we really love Him. We all need to remember that we only live once and we should strive to do our best in the vocation that God has given us by Baptism and our own decisions.

On the first page of the new calendars, which you received before Christmas, you will notice a picture of Lighthouse, an anchor and a windmill and the following words: “Each new year gives us the opportunity to renew our commitment as disciples of Jesus. We understand that all gifts are entrusted to us by God. We commit ourselves to return these gifts with increase. As stewards we offer our lives in service.”

The theme of Phil Lenahan’s January”Faith and Finances” addresses the importance of “Balancing Tithing, Saving, and Debt Reduction in a Down Economy” and he wrote the following: “An economic downturn can upend the best economic plans, but even during rough times, the principles you should use to set priorities for giving, saving and debt reduction remain the same. What are these principles?”

1. Recognize that all we have ultimately comes from the Lord and belongs to him (Dt. 10:14).
2. Be generous with the Lord as a way of thanking Him for the many gifts He has given you. The world says pay yourself first, but Scriptural principle is to pay God first (Pr. 3:9).
3. Have a plan and work the plan (Lk. 14:28-30).

In addition to paying the Lord from your first fruits, it’s a good idea - even during tough times - to give to a level that makes you stretch a bit. It’s called Sacrificial Giving, and the Lord honors such gifts, no matter the amount , because they are given out of love.

Before deciding how much to give, save, and apply to debt repayment, make sure you place all of these, along with the rest of your expenses into an annual spending plan. Without an effective plan, you’ll find yourself playing a shell game with your money, feeling as though you are making progress one moment, only to be caught off-guard by unexpected bills at another moment.

A well designed plan helps you see the big picture, allows you to make appropriate allocations between giving, saving and debt reduction, and provides a realistic understanding of the resources available for other categories. “God love you..”
