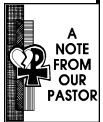

Dear Friends,



I have very good news for all adults and young people in our parish! On Ash Wednesday, Feb. 17th St. Peter, Prince of the Apostles Parish will provide all our families who attend Holy Mass a free MP3 formatted Catholic audio Bible. In other words, we will be able to listen to the New Testament as translated in the New American Bible. We will also provide all children 6-11 years of age a free MP3 KIDS Bible that includes Old and New Testament stories and 82 songs. This distribution is part of an exciting audio Bible listening program that the entire parish, Msgr. McGowan and I will begin this Lent.

Since 2008, when “The Year of Word of God” was declared by Pope Benedict XVI, Catholics throughout the world have been urged to read and or listen to the Holy Scriptures. Listening to a Catholic NAB Audio Bible is one way to renew our love of the scriptures and become closer to Christ and his Word. Many of the Saints, including St. Jerome have reminded us that “Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ.” We need to become more familiar with the Word of God.

We all can listen to the Word of God on these audio discs at home, work, in the car, as a family or even at the gym for only 28 minutes a day for 40 days. In those 40-days we will have listened to the entire dramatized NAB New Testament. This free Catholic MP3 audio Bible is being provided by “Faith Comes By Hearing”, a ministry that specializes in recording the Holy Scriptures in languages of people groups around the world, who do not like to read and also for those who are poor and illiterate and can not read the written word. Surveys tell us that most Americans prefer to hear the Word of God than to read it.

To support the world-wide ministry to provide audio Word of God to people groups served by Catholic Missionaries in Mexico, South America and Africa, our parish will be conducting a free-will special offering during all the Masses on March 7, 2010.

Remember: Distribution of the MP3 formatted Catholic audio Word of God will take place on Ash Wednesday to every family attending Mass. There will be special listening devices called “Bible Stick” (similar to Ipods) for sale at a cost of only \$20 but it may be best if you want this format to let us know, so we can order the correct amount. These Bible Sticks are especially useful for people who like to walk and listen at the same time. There is a display in the foyer of the Church today and samples of the MP2 Audio Bible, the KIDS Bible and the Bible Sticks are on the table and some volunteers will answer any questions you may have.

Matthew Kelly in his book, “Rediscovering Catholicism” writes the following; “Of all the books ever written or published, the Bible is the most widely read, studied, translated, and quoted. It is the best selling book of all times. When it comes to learning about the nature of God and his desires for us, no other book comes close. In the Bible, we discover the depth and generosity of God’s love, as well as his desire to soothe humanity’s yearning for truth and happiness.” Please pray for the success of “Faith Comes By Hearing” in our parish.
